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**Proctor Details** - For Judging Exams, provide a list of proctors for the exam. We require at least two proctors per site and allow up to three proctors. The BJCP requires proctors that are active in the program and have a National rank or higher. When possible, we further desire that at least one proctor be a *Master* judge or a judge with a minimum tasting score of 90 and with at least 20 judging experience points. Proctors with qualifications other than these require pre-approval from the Exam Directors. Proctors may be contacted by the Exam Directorate to confirm participation.
